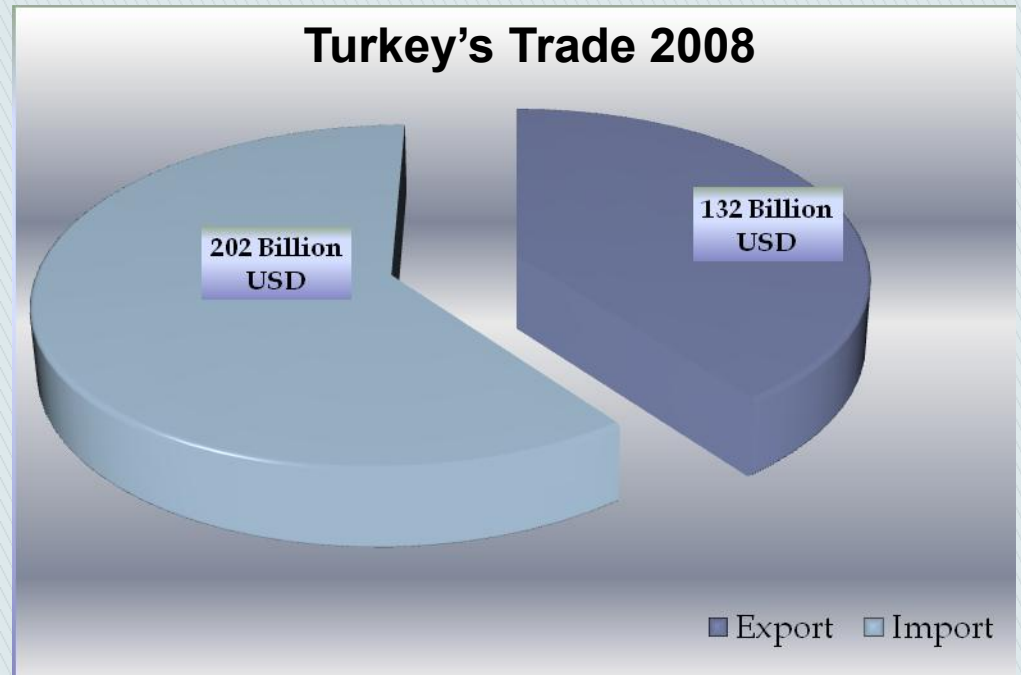


Foreign Trade Figures 2008

▶ 334 Billion USD Yearly Total

- ❑ 132 Billion USD Export
- ❑ 202 Billion USD Import



TURKEY - EU

Turkey's Trade with EU is 41,4% of overall Turkish Foreign Trade

- EU Exports of Total: 48 %
- EU Imports of Total: 37 %



Aim: Increasing the Economic Potential

- ▶ Elimination of Bottlenecks
- ▶ Liberalization of Services



50% of Turkey-EU Trade is realized by Road Transport



EU's Barriers: Transportation Quotas, CEMT Docs and Visas

- ▶ Transportation Quotas are Preventing the Free Usage of the Services (i.e. Italy, Austria, etc..)
- ▶ Unsufficient Amount of CEMT Documents
- ▶ Visas for Truck Drivers where their duration in EU territory remains limited.
