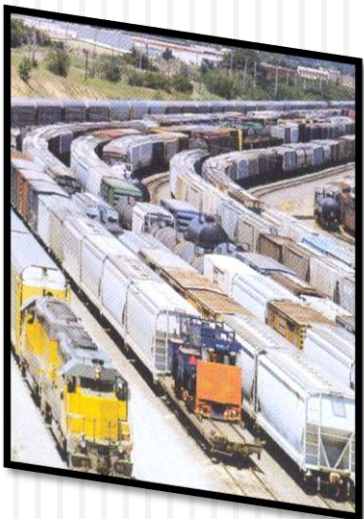

Youngest fleet in Europe, fastest growing airline transport and infrastructure



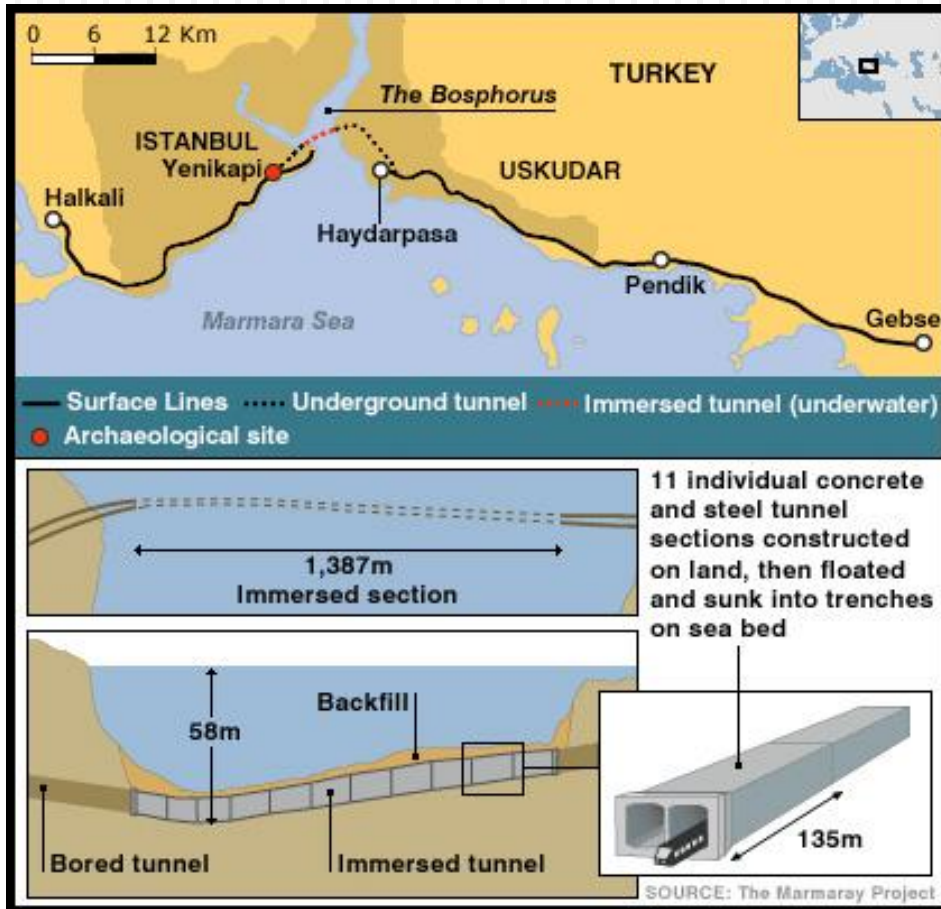
Intl. Truck fleet around 45.000

Bilateral relations
